

California Consumer Privacy Act (CCPA)

- Goal: Give users more control over their personal information.
- Introduced four key rights:
 - The right to know
 - 2. The right to delete
 - 3. The right to opt-out of sale
 - 4. The right to non-discrimination
- Signed: June 28, 2018
- Enforced: July 1, 2020


The Right to Opt-out of Sale

Users have the right to opt-out of the sale of their personal information.

Businesses must provide a "a clear and conspicuous link" on the homepage of their website entitled "Do Not Sell My Personal Information" or "Do Not Sell My Personal Info"


Data Sale (Top 500 U.S.)








